### PRINCIPAL MESSAGE:

**We are thrilled to be back to school.**

Our students are doing amazingly well with the protocols outlined by our board and the health unit to keep everyone safe. They are learning to socially distance, to wear a mask and to continuously wash and sanitize their hands. We are very proud of our students.

Staff, students and parents/guardians are required to complete self-screening daily. Staff, students and parents/guardians should not attend the school if they are exhibiting any of the symptoms of Covid-19. If your child has symptoms, you must seek medical advice to determine if a test is necessary. If a COVID test is recommended and you do not wish to get one, your child is to self-isolate for 14 days. If a COVID test is not recommended, your child can return to school when they are symptom free for 24 hours (48 hours for vomiting / diarrhea).

## SAFETY FIRST

## SCHOOL COUNCIL

## BREAKFAST PROGRAM

Due to covid protocol we are offering individual servings of cereal, cheese, fruit, breads etc. They are being delivered to the classroom in a grab and go format. There is no cost for this program. We are not offering free milk at this time.

## ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION

According to Board Policy, oral medication may only be administered to students at school if the form, "Administration of Oral Medication" has been completed and signed by both a parent/guardian and the physician. Contact the office if a form is required.

## BUSING

The school **must** be notified if your child is not going home on the bus. Otherwise students will be put on the bus at the end of the day with the expectation that you will be waiting for them at their stop. **Requests for students to ride buses other than their regular bus is not permitted.** Bus service is a privilege and students are expected to co-operate fully with the bus driver and follow bus rules. If problems arise on the bus, parents will be contacted and students may lose the privilege of riding the bus.

## STUDENT CELL PHONES /PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICES

While the school recognizes the need for students to have on their person before and after school hours, PEDs (smartphones and iPods), these devices are to be powered-off during school hours, unless being used for instructional purposes with teacher permission. If students need to contact their parents, they can use the school phone. Similarly, parents are encouraged to contact the office regarding any changes to their child's schedule and their child will be informed of these changes. Any time a PED is being used without permission, students will be expected to relinquish the device until the end of the day.



## Use of Video Camera on a Bus

Stockdale Public School and the Boards transportation organization, Student Transportation Services of Central Ontario (STSCO), are committed to providing a safe environment for all students while riding on school buses. In order to assist school administration and transportation staff with the monitoring of safe practices on school buses, selected school vehicles may be equipped to permit videotaping of passengers while riding the bus. Current policies and practices concerning student behaviour and discipline will continue.

The use of video cameras is considered a tool to assist us in maintaining a safe and acceptable environment on school buses. Your child's bus may be so equipped in the future and this letter is intended to provide you with courtesy notice regarding the same. The type of video equipment which may put in place has been successfully used by the School Board over the past several years and is covered in related Board Policy entitled "Safety and Conduct on School Buses".
